Home Educator Day at Monticello



Join other homeschool families for the first Home Educator Day at Monticello, the home of Thomas Jefferson. This event will be held from **9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Wednesday, March 10, 2010.**

Take a special guided tour of the house where Jefferson enjoyed his retirement years with his large extended family. Explore the new Thomas Jefferson Visitor Center and Smith Education Center, which includes the hands-on Griffin Discovery Room, the film *Thomas Jefferson's World*, and innovative exhibitions on architecture, the Monticello plantation, and the creation of the United States.

Participate in a Plantation Community Tour of Mulberry Row to learn more about the lives of enslaved people who lived and worked at Monticello. Roll hoops and play games on the West Lawn, just as Jefferson's grandchildren did 200 years ago. Stop by the interactive indoor and outdoor activity stations that will allow students to explore a variety of Jeffersonian topics.

Light meals and refreshments are available in the Monticello Café. The Monticello Museum Shop provides shopping opportunities for books and other learning materials related to the exploration of the worlds of Thomas Jefferson.

Take advantage of special home educator discounted tickets. Advance purchase tickets are \$8 per person for children (age 6 and up) and adults. Tickets can also be purchased on March 10 for \$10 per person. Admission for children age 5 and under is free but they must be registered and ticketed. The home educator's rate includes a timed ticket to tour the house, admission to the new Thomas Jefferson Visitor Center and Smith Education Center, and the special activity stations.

Advanced ticket purchase is strongly recommended. Home Educators Day activities will be held rain or shine. **Tickets can be purchased beginning January 15th. Refunds will not be available after March 3.**
