



# Board Welcomes New Member and Officers

Charles T. Cullen of Chicago has joined the Board of Trustees of the Thomas Jefferson Foundation, Inc., and J. Stewart Bryan III of Richmond and Alice W. Handy of Charlottesville have begun serving as vice chairman and secretary, respectively.

Cullen, whose four-year term began Jan. 1, is president and librarian of the Newberry Library in Chicago. The holder of degrees from the University of the South (Sewanee), Florida State University, and the University of Virginia, he has served as editor of *The Papers of John Marshall* at the College of William and Mary and *The Papers of Thomas Jefferson* at Princeton University.

Bryan and Handy were elected to their new positions at the Board of Trustees meeting in November. At the same meeting, Thomas A. Saunders III of New York was re-elected chairman and Jeffrey C. Walker of Wilton, Conn., formerly treasurer, was elected vice chairman and treasurer.

All officers' two-year terms officially began Jan. 1.

Bryan, who joined the TJF board in 2002, is chairman and chief executive officer of Media General Inc., a publicly owned communications company based in Richmond. Handy, a trustee since 1999, is the founder of Investure, a private investment firm based in Charlottesville.

Saunders, a member of the TJF board since 1997, became chairman in 2002, the same year Walker, who joined the board in 2001, became treasurer.

Also on Jan. 1, Michael R. Beschloss of Washington, D.C., a historian and author, began his second term as a trustee.
