Monticello's Donors Share Common Purpose, Vision

It was 23 years into the last century when the Thomas Jefferson Memorial Foundation, with a stated mission of preservation and education, incorporated to purchase Monticello from the Levy family, stewards of the house and land for almost 90 years. In the intervening

years, the Foundation has steadily expanded its role as a museum, research center, and educational institution. Today, we begin a new century and a new millennium with an endowment

worth \$45 million and a group of committed friends and supporters whose names we proudly acknowledge here.

More than 1,200 individual donors contributed a total of \$7,757,143 to Monticello in 2000. They range from a man in Poland who sent American currency to a Virginia couple who made a \$1 million contribution to the Jefferson Library. They all share a common purpose and vision: a recognition that Thomas Jefferson's accomplishments and legacy are as meaningful today as they were two centuries ago, and the realization that there is no better place to learn about them than at Monticello.

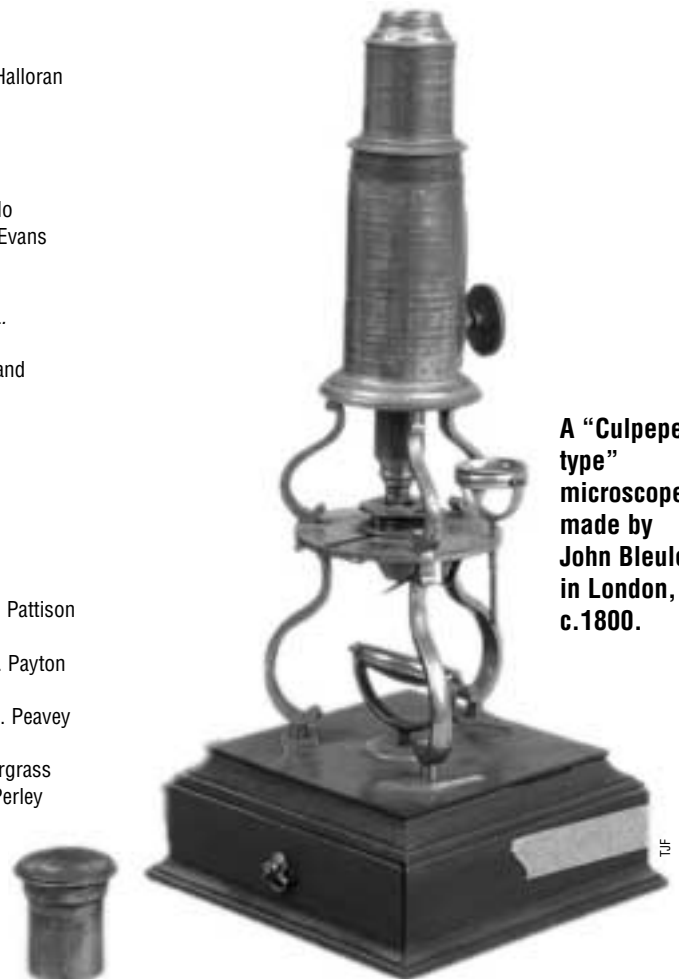
